


Swimming and PE Sports Funding 2020/2021

Sadly, this is the last cohesive data we have due to COVID19 hitting within the 2020/2021 academic year. Between the national Lockdown, periods of time when school was only open for key worker children and individual families needing to isolate for longer periods, we were unable to consistently maintain swimming. We did however have bookings both at the swimming pool and with the coach company and did still incur some charges for these. As a school and Governing body, we still decided to remain in bubbles and restrict our pupil's contact thereby not allowing any off site excursions for the entire academic year.

What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres?	98%
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]?	83%
What percentage of your current Year 6 cohort perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations?	83%
Schools can choose to use the Primary PE and Sport Premium to provide additional provision for swimming but this must be for activity over and above the National Curriculum requirements. Have you used it in this way? WE aim to have our Y6 swim at least 100m rather than the national expectation of 25m. 75% achieved this standard 19-20 – note Lockdown ceased swimming in early March.	Yes
